Microsoft Edge options were missing from Group Policy. Had issues adding to domain controllers, so decided to add locally to each machine as needed.



Downloaded the latest Microsoft Edge Policy Templates from the Microsoft website. I've added at: T:\HRMS\MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates

Need to copy the MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates folder locally to the machine

As an Admin account, copy the 3 .admx files from

MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates\Windows\admx to the local machine's PolicyDefinitions folder (generally located C:\Windows\PolicyDefinitions)
