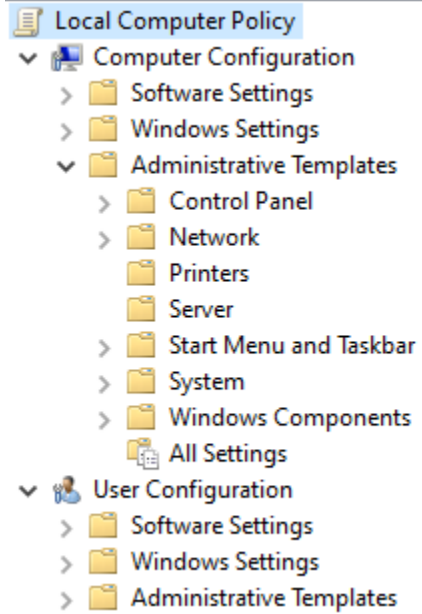


Microsoft Edge options were missing from Group Policy. Had issues adding to domain controllers, so decided to add locally to each machine as needed.



Downloaded the latest Microsoft Edge Policy Templates from the Microsoft website. I've added at: T:\HRMS\MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates

Need to copy the MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates folder locally to the machine

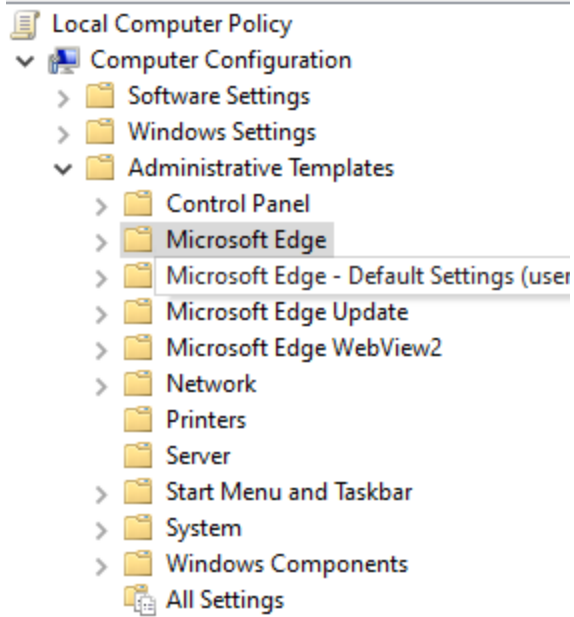
As an Admin account, copy the 3 .admx files from MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates\Windows\admx to the local machine's PolicyDefinitions folder (generally located C:\Windows\PolicyDefinitions)

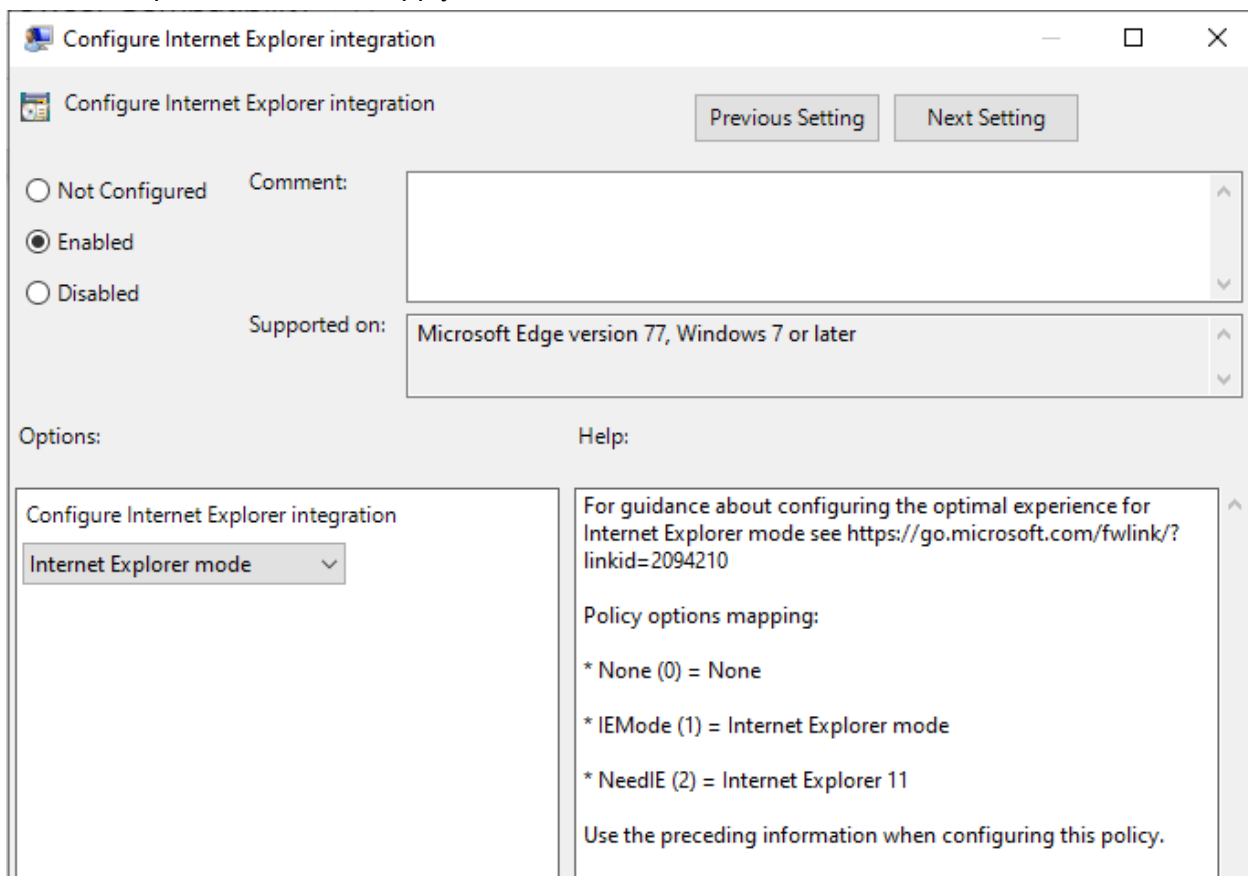
Copy the 3 .adml files from MicrosoftEdgePolicyTemplates.zip\windows\admx\en-US to C:\Windows\PolicyDefinitions\en-US

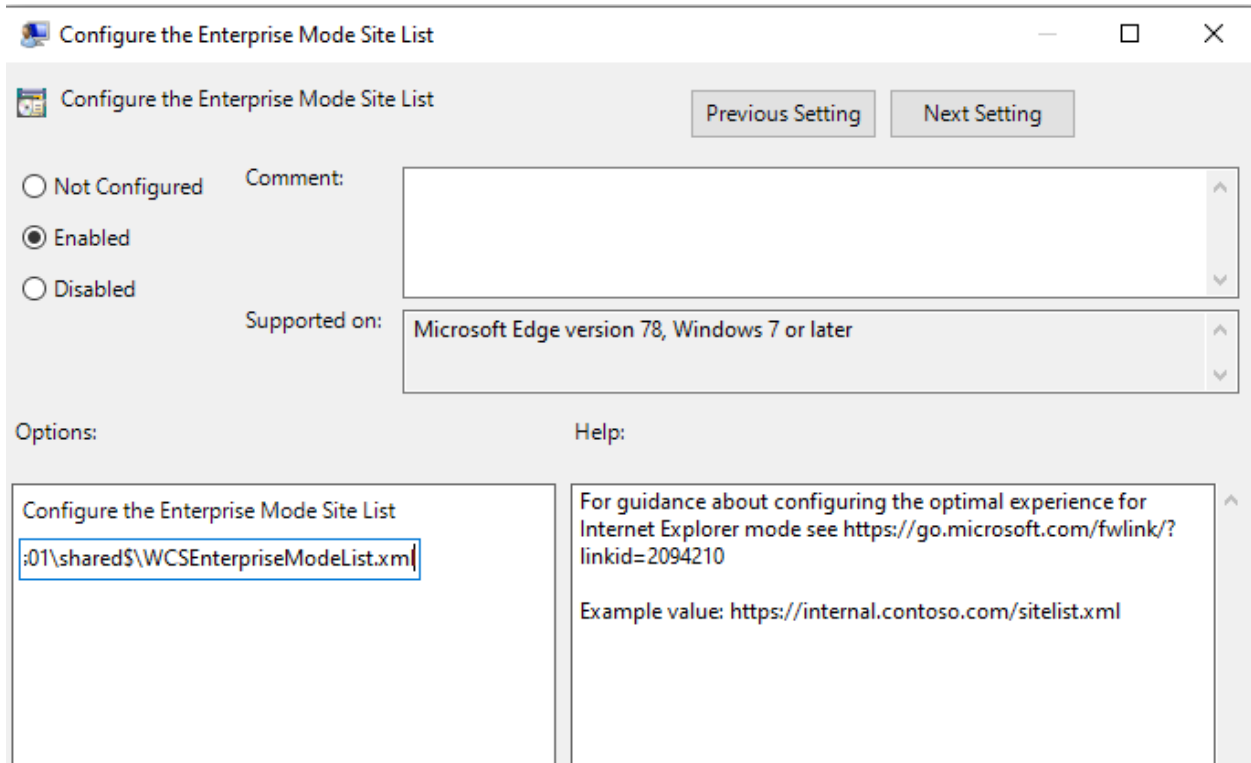
Open up Group Policy Editor (gpedit.msc). Edge policies should now be added



Find the “Configure Internet Explorer Integration” setting. Set to “Enabled” and change to “Internet Explorer mode” and apply

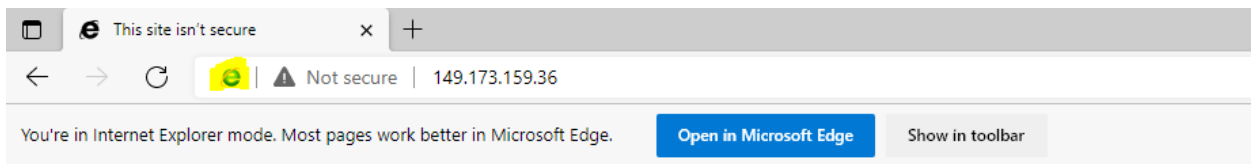


Find the “Configure the Enterprise Mode Site List” setting. Change to “Enabled” and enter:
\\wcsfs01\shared\$WCSEnterpriseModeList.xml



Note: I downloaded the Enterprise Mode Site List Manager from Microsoft’s site to create the xml file. I had to enter the HRMS Website and saved at the location noted above.

Open the HRMS site. It should have the IE icon to show it’s opening in IE Compatibility Mode. You’ll need to select “More information” -> Go to the webpage

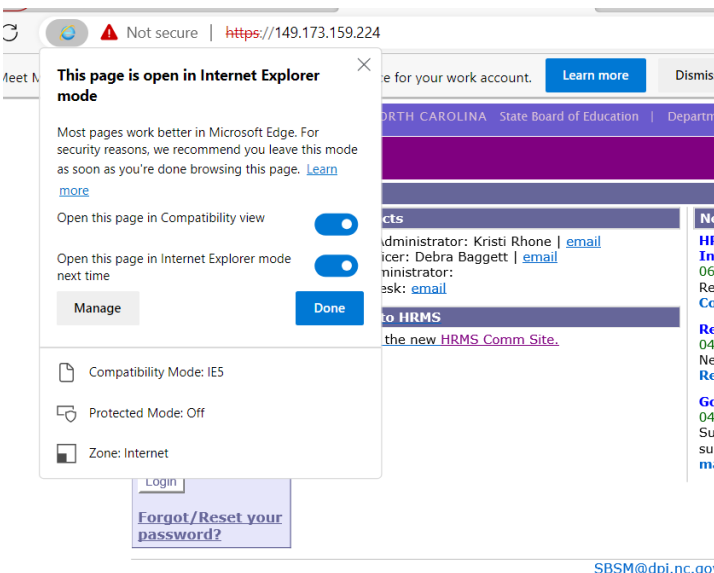
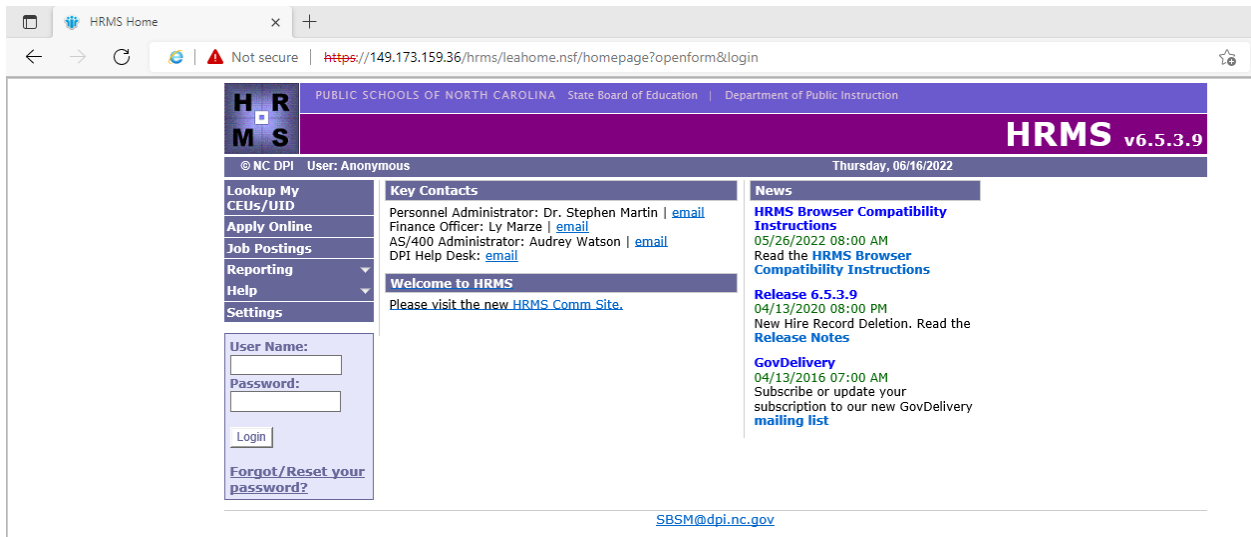
